We are pleased to announce the availability of Access ACS to the family of East Boulder Baptist Church! Access ACS is a Web-based companion to our church database, giving you and the staff access to vital information over the Internet.

With communication as its backbone, Access ACS becomes a central point of connection for our church to build stronger relationships, become financially and actively involved, and connect to areas of ministry and growth.

When you connect to Access ACS, you are connecting to a 128 bit encrypted secure connect, the same thing most online banking programs use. Your information in the database is not searchable, on any internet search engine, because it is behind the secure log in. Your information – your personal profile, as well as giving history are available only to you. You will be able to view your own contributions, but you will not be able to view contribution information or anyone outside your family.

You can notify the church office to changes and corrections in your profile by clicking the “pencil” icon, which will create a change request that will be processed promptly. Changes will be reviewed and accepted by the church administrator.

In your personal preferences, you can decide whether other people can see your address, telephone number and photos, as well as decide if you want people to see your information in group directories.

If the login screen says you cannot be found, more than likely we don't have your current email address in our files. Please [email us](#) so that we can update this information. Once that is complete, you should be able to finish the log in process for the first time.

We are looking forward to everyone having the chance to participate in this program and its use in expanding our ministry. Please contact the church office if you have any questions.

How does Access ACS Work?

- Access ACS is available to regular attenders of EBBC
- In order to log on to Access ACS, we must have an e-mail address on file for you. Your first name, last name and e-mail address must match what is on file, or you will not be allowed to create a log in. For example, if you aren't sure if we have you listed as William or Bill, just call the office to find out.
- You must register as a new user the first time. Underneath the blue box, you'll see “Need a login? Click here” and you will click on that link.
- The next screen is the Account Sign Up. Type in your e-mail address, First Name and Last Name and click Find Me.
- If your information matches, you will get a message indicating you have successfully set up a member account. A user name and password will be emailed to the e-mail address that is on file for you.

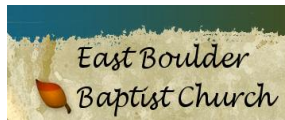
You will need to remember your user name but don't worry about trying to memorize the obscure password ACS provides because you will be required to change it the first time you log in.

Creating a Strong Password

When creating or resetting a password, you must get a green bar for password strength. As you create your password, remember the following:

- It should not contain your user name or e-mail.
- It should not include any of the following characters: "<&>/\;%{space}”
- It should contain two or more numbers.
- It should contain both lower and upper case characters.
- It should be over 8 characters long.
